We will of course pass these on to you as soon as is possible.

Reminders:

Jewellery

We do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are small objects of religious significance, which must be removed before any physical activity including playtimes and lunchtimes. We ask the children to remove these objects during PE and games. Please use the beginning of the summer break to have your child's ears pierced if you so wish so that your child can return to school without earrings.

Footwear

We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes with platform soles or high heels in school, so we do not allow this. In addition to this, children are unable to fully emerge themselves in activities during playtime and lunchtime.
