SCIENCE Forces

MATHS Multiplication, Division, Length, Perimeter and Area.

In our second half term, we will focus on our use of multiplication, division, length and perimeter though reasoning. We will be learning to:

TOPIC One Continent, Many Countries (History/Geography/DT and Art)

In our new topic, we will be exploring the different societies, cultures, arts and foods of European countries including Spain, France, Turkey, Greece, Italy and Denmark.

We will be learning to:

- Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom and a region in a European country.
- Prepare and cook a variety of predominantly savoury dishes safely and hygienically including, the use of a heat source Use a range of techniques
- Suggest where we might find answers to questions considering a range of sources
- Show qualities using cross hatching, pointillism, sidestrokes, use of rubber to draw/highlight

COMPUTING Sensing and Logging

Our focus for this half term will be to use hardware and software to find data from our local environment to find answers to questions we have posed.

We will be learning to:

- Know and use a range of input and output devices
- Collect data from various input devices, including sensors and application software.

RE Why is Advent important to Christians?
