GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

Castles

During topic lessons, we will be studying castles of the past and comparing our lives today with life in medieval England.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Learn about the different features of castles.
- Design the best place to build a castle based on the geographical features.
- Compare and contrast different types of castles.
- Understand ways in which we find out about the past.
- Develop awareness of the past, using common words and phrases.
- Begin to use dates, showing where places, people and events fit into a broad chronological framework.
- Use world map, atlases and globes to identify the UK, countries, continents and oceans.

MATHS

Place value/Addition/Subtraction

- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally.
