ENGLISH

MATHS

Multiplication & Division, Fractions, Geometry, Measures

Our Objectives will be to:

- Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, using concrete objects and pictorial representations
- Recognise, name and find a half/quarter as one of two/four equal parts of an object, shape and quantity.
- Recognise shapes in different orientations and sizes
- Understand, follow and use positional vocabulary including: left and right; full, half and quarter turns.
- Measure and record (using a ruler, weighing scales and containers): lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity & volume, time.
- Begin to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

ART/DT

Our main project this half term will be planning and making healthy snacks.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Explore and evaluate a range of existing products
- Evaluate their ideas and products against design criteria
- Use appropriate equipment to weigh and measure ingredients
- Prepare simple dishes safely and hygienically
- Name and sort foods into the five groups of the 'eat well' plate
- Know where food comes from
- Hold a large paint brush correctly
- Make marks using paint with a variety of tools
- Recognise, name and mix primary and secondary colours
