- Proof reads for spelling, grammar and punctuation errors and selfcorrects

SCIENCE

State of Matter

Our Objectives will be to:

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled
- Conduct an experiment on the temperature objects melt/ evaporate in degrees Celsius (°C)
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle
- Associate the rate of evaporation with temperature

COMPUTING

During this half term, we will be looking at communicating online, focusing on blogging.

- Use mental and formal written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide with increasing confidence.
- Solve problems (one and two step) across all four operations.
