

ENGLISH

Biographies/Narrative writing.

In English this half term we will begin by exploring the features of biographies, using them to find out information about famous inventors before writing one of our own. We will then read the story 'Rosie Revere, Engineer' as we explore different styles of narrative writing.

- Selects words for effect to support the purpose of writing and engages readers' interests

Place Value/Written and mental methods/Measures/Shapes

Our Objectives will be to:

- Develop knowledge and understanding of number and place value of two and three digit numbers.
- Use mental and formal written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide with increasing confidence.
- Solve problems (one and two step) using all four operations.
- Develop understanding of measures including time and money.

SCIENCE

Light

Our Objectives will be to:

- Recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes.
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.
- Find patterns in the way that the sizes of shadows change.
