GEOGRAPHY

Weather and Climate

Our Objectives will be to:

- Know and understand different types of weather.

- Investigate places we have been.
- Understand what Climate Change is.
- Make and justify decisions about best holidays based on specific criteria.

COMPUTING

Produce a tourist guide.

During this half term, we will be using online sources to research an area in a different climate zone and produce a tourist guide.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Use search technologies effectively
- Develop an understanding of how results are selected and ranked.
- Select, use and combine a variety of software to design and create a tourist guide for a place within a chosen climate zone
- Add images from a search engine into the tourist guide.

MATHS

Measurement

During this half term, we will focus on units of measurement; including time and using our multiplication knowledge to solve problems.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Tell the time to the nearest minute on an analogue clock and a digital clock.
- Record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours
- Begin to compare duration of events.
- Begin to add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using £ and p in practical contexts.
- Recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems involving multiplication.
