Poetry/Narrative writing.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Uses the structure of stories which have been read to write their own narrative
- Evaluates the effectiveness of own and others' writing
- Proof read for spelling, grammar and punctuation errors and self-correct

MATHS

Fractions, Measurement, Geometry and Statistics

Our Objectives will be to:

- Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects.
- Add and subtract, compare and order fractions with the same denominators.
- Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml)- including mixed units
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p.
- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.
- Draw 2-D shapes and recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations and describe them

SCIENCE

Plants

Our Objectives will be to:

1. Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
2. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant
3. Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
4. Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
5. Compare the effect of different factors on plant growth
