Our Objectives will be to:

- Makes simple improvements to writing.
- Proof-reads own writing to check for basic spelling, sentence and punctuation errors.
- Use conjunctions within writing.
- Use simple adjectives for descriptions.
- Use punctuation: capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, question marks and apostrophes.

MUSIC

Singing

Our Music focus will be based on learning the songs for the Christmas production.

Our Objectives will be to:

- To use voices expressively and creatively singing song, speaking chants and rhymes.
- Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using inter-related dimensions of music.
- Play tuned and un-tuned instruments musically.

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

London

During topic lessons we will be studying the geography and history of our capital city, London.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Use world map, atlases and globes to identify the UK, countries, continents and oceans.
- Begin to use dates, showing where places, people and events fit into a broad chronological framework.
- Learn about the different landmarks in London.
- Compare and contrast different periods of history in London, looking at the differences and similarities.
- Understand ways in which we find out about the past.
- Develop awareness of the past, using common words and phrases.

MATHS

Our Objectives will be to:

- Develop addition and subtraction methods and use these in problems involving money and measures.
- Develop understanding of multiplication and division, including learning times tables for x2 and x10.
- Develop accuracy of measures, choosing correct units.
- Consolidate telling of time for quarter past/to.
- Begin to use simple fractions of length, shapes and amounts.
- Identify and describe 3D shapes.
- Interpret and construct simple pictograms/tally charts.

SCIENCE

Animals

- To understand HOW to resolve issues and move on.

COMPUTING

Real World Modelling

We will link our computing skills to our topic theme on London.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Understand what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs on digital devices; and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions.
- Know that computers have no intelligence and that computers can do nothing unless a programme is run.
- Find content from the world wide web, using a web browser.
- Talk about my work and make changes to improve it.

ART/DT

London

Our Objectives will be to:

- To design purposeful products based on design criteria.
- To assemble, join and combine materials using simple fixing materials.
- To suggest how products can be improved.
- To understand about the movement of simple mechanisms including levers, sliders, wheels and axles.
- Begin to control lines to create simple drawings from observations.
- Begin to add detail to line drawings.
- Work from observation and known objects.
- Begin to collect ideas in sketchbooks.
- Prepare simple food dishes safely and hygienically and use techniques for cutting.
