GEOGRAPHY

Climate Change

During topic lessons, we will be studying climate change and the implications on the planet.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Locate the position and significance of latitude Identify, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic Circle

Describe and understand key aspects of:

- Physical geography, including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle
- Human geography, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water

And

- use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied

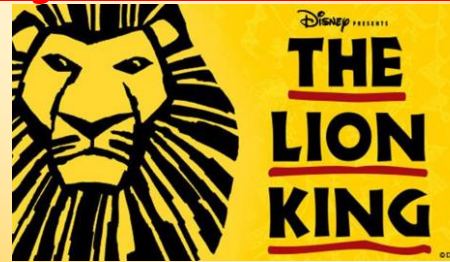
MATHS
