ENGLISH

In English during this half term, we will be focussing predominantly on poetry and letter writing. These will be directly linked to our World War One theme and will include looking at:

SCIFNCE

In Science during this half term our focus will be on electricity, we will be:

- 1. Building simple circuits
- Testing how the volume of a buzzer changes depending upon the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit

- 4. Drawing circuit diagrams
- Identifying the effect if changing one component at a time in a circuit
