

GEOGRAPHY

This term our geography topic is 'Africa' We will be looking at the following aspects:

- ⇒ Countries in Africa
- ⇒ Climate
- ⇒ Geographical features
- ⇒ Capital Cities
- \Rightarrow Comparing a region in Africa to a region in the UK

LITERACY

This half term, our focus will be persuasive writing, stories with suspense and poetry. We will be exploring these different text types and focusing on the use of description and using organisational devices. As well as this, we will develop our proof-reading skills in relation to punctuation and grammar. In Reading, we will be reading new texts which will allow us to compare and contrast different styles of writing.

NUMERACY

This half term we will be concentrating on the following aspects of maths:

- ⇒ Division
- ⇒ Naming and measuring angles
- ⇒ Identifying, comparing, ordering and simplifying fractions
- ⇒ Data handling and statistics

ART

Our focus in art this term is aboriginal art. We will be using the history of the Native Australians as inspiration and will use a range of media to create aboriginal art.





MUSIC

This term the children will be building on their knowledge of singing through practicing a range of singing styles and songs

SCIENCE

The children will be investigating Earth and space. They will learn about:

- Sizes of solar bodies
- ♦ Rotation of the Earth
- Creation of the seasons
- ♦ The moon
- ♦ The sun and stars

HISTORY

The children will be exploring significant historical events in British history.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Children will be designing, building and testing an all terrain space buggy.





COMPUTING

Children will be:

- Researching facts about the Solar system
- Creating a documentary on the moon landing
- Using programming software to improve their moon buggies
