

## ENGLISH Instructions, poetry and stories with familiar settings

In English lessons, we will be reading The Angel of Nitshill Road by Anne Fine as well as writing instructions based on our DT/Art projects. As well as this, we will be writing poetry about wings and flight.

**We will be learning to:**

## SCIENCE Sound

This half term in Science, we will be investigating sound and how waves allow us to hear.

**We will be learning to:**

- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating.
- Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.
- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

## MUSIC Recorder

Our focus for this half term will be reading music to perform and appreciating a range of music and the contribution of wind instruments within this.

**We will be learning to:**

- Play their recorder using appropriate volume & control.

## TOPIC Tobias and the Angel

### (History/Geography/DT and Art)

Within our Topic lessons, we will explore the painting 'Tobias and the Angel' by Italian Renaissance painter Verrocchio. From this painting, we will explore the journey of Tobias and the history of angels within different cultures. We will also create our own versions of The Angel of the North.

**We will be learning to:**

- Develop artistic vocabulary to describe and to discuss work.
- Compare and contrast their environmental regions.
- Follow a route on a large-scale map.
- Describe some of the similarities and differences between different periods.

## COMPUTING Games Maker

Our focus for this half term will be to continue to explore how games are made and use our coding knowledge to create our own apps.

**We will be learning to:**

- Use features debugging and programming to give commands within a program.
- Design sprites and options which are appealing to our target audience.
- Evaluate our own and others' work to make improvements.

## RE Commitment

During Summer Term 1, we will be exploring what commitment means and how this is shown through religious practice.

**We will be learning to:**

- Explore the ceremony of marriage in different cultures.
- Discuss how we show commitment within our own lives.

## MATHS Decimals, money and percentages, statistics

In our first half term in Summer, we will revisit and extend our knowledge of using decimals then move onto work involving understanding position and direction.

**We will be learning to:**
