Narrative Traditional and Fairy Tales

In English this term we will be studying non-fiction and information texts and also be writing more poetry.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Discusses what they have written with the teacher or other pupils
- Begins to distinguish between fact and fiction
- Write instructions
- Read and write rhyming poetry

MUSIC

Weather and Travel

Our Music focus will be to explore sounds and perform.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Exploring and controlling dynamics (volume), duration and timbre with voices, body percussion and instructions
- Combine voices, movement and instructions to perform a chant and song

Geography

Around the World - Climate

In Geography this term we will be learning about how weather and climate differs throughout the world. We will be learning about why we have different weather and how it affects the landscape and needs of those living there.

Our Objectives will be to:

- To know how weather differs around the world
- To locate places on a map that we have
- To understand that different countries have different weather and live accordingly

MATHS

We continue with mental addition, subtraction, multiplication and division with number and place value. We will also be learning to tell the time and recognise fractions of shapes.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Know number properties, including odd/even
- Count in 2s, 5s and 20s
- Understand $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ fractions as part of a whole
- Tell the time to the nearest half and whole hour
- Measure lengths and heights
- Understand place value

SCIENCE

Materials
