- Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians

HISTORY

Ancient Incas

During History lessons we will be studying the ancient civilization of the Incas.

Our Objectives will be to:

- know and understand significant aspects of the history of the wider world: the nature of ancient civilisations; the expansion and dissolution of empires; characteristic features of past non-European societies; achievements and follies of mankind
- understand historical concepts such as continuity and change, cause and consequence, similarity, difference and significance, and use them to make connections, draw contrasts, analyse trends, frame historically-valid questions and create their own structured accounts, including written narratives and analyses
- understand the methods of historical enquiry, including how evidence is used rigorously to make historical claims, and discern how and why contrasting arguments and interpretations of the past have been constructed

MATHS

Problem Solving and Reasoning

During this half term, we will focus on problem solving using all four operations, including measures.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Develop competence in calculation mental and written methods for all four operations.
- Solve problems using division and multiplication.
- Solve problems (including money) using addition and subtraction.
- Solve problems using measures, including time.
