# Changes of circumstances

Thank you to parents and family members who have remembered to update your contact details i.e. address and phone numbers when they change.

All key Stage 1 children are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. **In addition to this,** if you claim child tax credit your child may also receive other benefits. If this is the case, please bring your National Insurance Number and date of birth to our office where Mrs Haswell will discreetly check if your child is entitled to other benefits in school.

All schools receive 'Pupil Premium Money' for families who are entitled—from Nursery to Year 6 so if any family feel they may be entitled, please do not hesitate to get in touch with us. If drop off/pick up time is not convenient for you (It is often a really busy time in our school office) then give us a ring to arrange a convenient time.

## **Reception Applications 2019**

If your child turns five between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 you need to apply for a school place (for whichever Primary School you would like them to attend) via <a href="http://www.durham.gov.uk/schooladmissions">http://www.durham.gov.uk/schooladmissions</a>. Please note, if you want your child to attend our school for Reception, you must still apply for a place even if your child attends Nursery here. Applications opened on 12th September 2018 and close on 15th January 2019.




