#### GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

#### London

During topic lessons, we will be studying the geography and history of our capital city, London, with specific focus on 'The Great Fire of London'.

#### Our Objectives will be to:

- Use world map, atlases and globes to identify the UK, countries, continents and oceans.
- Begin to use dates, showing where places, people and events fit into a broad chronological framework.
- Learn about the different landmarks in London.
- Compare and contrast different periods of history in London, looking at the differences and similarities.
- Understand ways in which we find out about the past.
- Develop awareness of the past, using common words and phrases.
