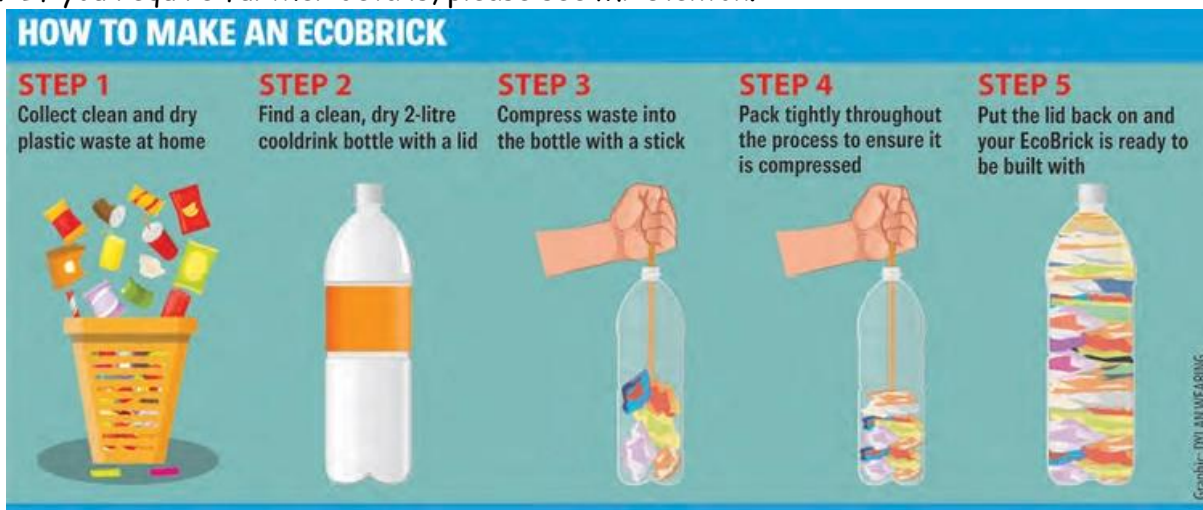
The meetings are as follows:
