Instructions/Narrative writing.

In English this half term we will be studying the narrative Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, by Roald Dahl. We will also be identifying features of instructions and writing our own linked to our Chocolate topic.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Uses headings and sub-headings to organise and structure non-fiction writing
- Writes for a range of real purposes and audiences across the curriculum
- Reads aloud own writing to an audience and uses appropriate emotion and tone
- Uses the possessive apostrophe with regular plural words
- Spells words using a range of prefixes.
- Begins to use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech
- Finds main clauses within a sentence
- Selects words for effect to support the purpose of writing and engages readers' interests.

SCIENCE

State of Matter

Our Objectives will be to:

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled
- Conduct an experiment on the temperature objects melt/ evaporate in degrees Celsius (°C)
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle
- Associate the rate of evaporation with temperature
