Try some leaf rubbing with a crayon.	Make an obstacle course all based on the number five. Can you do 5 jumps, then 5 steps, how about 5 turns?	Make a kite and see if it will fly. Think carefully about what material might be best to use, we don't want the kite to be blown away!	Why not wash the car?
Read a nursery rhyme a day for the whole week.	Blow some bubbles, how many of them can you pop?	Paint rocks. You could paint your family, or you could paint a story character.	Share a bedtime story together.
Have a go at some fine motor activities to strengthen your fingers! Can you tie a hair bobble in someone's hair? Can you open a bottle of water? Can you sort some tiny objects?	Can you make your own bed? How many seconds will it take you? Why not set a timer and see if you can do it before the timer gets to 20.	Make a bird feeder in your garden.	Play some races, you could race while carrying a ball on a bat, be careful, don't drop that ball!
Find as many objects that you can find that begin with the sound 'a'. If you get time, you could try other letters of the alphabet.	Enjoy some water play in the garden. You can use different sized containers/ buckets/cups/bowls to play with.	Help to water the plants around your home or in your garden.	If the weather is nice outside, you could draw around your shadow.
Play a game of I spy with my little eye.	Play a game of hide an seek with an item. Ask an adult to hide the item and then direct you to where it is. Is it over, under, though, on top of?	See how far you can kick a ball, who will kick the furthest?	Sit quietly in the garden and put a timer on, listen to the birds / other noises in the environment for two minutes.
