Children learning in School (Critical workers and vulnerable children)

- Arrangements have been made for this week. Please contact school if you are a critical worker and have not been contacted.
- Once a place has been confirmed, you have a place for the rest of the half term. You do not need to contact school each week to let us know you require a place.
- Children in school will be taught in their usual classes with their usual teacher. They will be given the same tasks as what is set out on the Learning Grids which children at home will be working from.
- Children should continue to wear a fresh uniform each day. Just as you have done in the Autumn Term.
- You will be notified by Text from your child's class teacher, when your child needs to arrive in a PE kit. Please dress warmly.
- If your child brings a packed lunch to school, please continue to do this in a disposable bag. If your child has a school lunch, these will continue to be provided.
- Children will enter school at 9am (no staggered times are needed). Please continue to use the one way system we have in place.
 - Reception will leave at 3pm.
 - Year 1 and Year 2 at 3:10pm
 - Key Stage 2 children at 3:20pm
- Nursery - If you are entitled to 15 hours, please collect/bring your child at 12 noon Wednesday from the main entrance. Nursery children will leave at 3pm during the full day sessions.

Please log on to Tapestry as the Teachers and Teaching Assistants will provide some activities for you to complete at home. Teachers will text you when an activity has been set. Tapestry has been very successful – thank you everyone for your participation and engagement.
