Once you are happy that your image/pose demonstrates the relationship of your characters, sketch the portrait. Begin with a bold outline then add the finer details to it.

In particular, focus on adding clothing details and background details. Can you make any background details more subtle, like a clue someone could only pick up if they looked really carefully? Experiment with sketching portraits portraying different relationships, which is your favourite and why?
