English

In English during this half term, we will be exploring:

- diaries;
- narrative writing; and
- news reports.



Geography

In geography our question will be 'What might we see on a holiday?'

We will be learning to:

- locate the world's continents, locate the equator, locate the UK and its capitals;
- learn new key geographical vocabulary;
- compare the human and physical geography of two small areas:
- Working like a geographer using aerial photographs and atlases; and
- devise a simple map, using simple compass directions to describe location of features on a map.

Science

In Science during this half term, our focus will be on plants. We will be learning to:

- observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants; and
- find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
