

## English

In English during this half term, we will be looking at a Roman Myths and Legends which we will use as inspiration for our own writing.

**We will be exploring:**

- Recounts/Diaries
- Narrative writing
- Instructions
- Poetry



## Science

**During this half term our focus will be Plants.**

We will be learning to:

- Investigate requirements of plants for survival and growth.
- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants



## History

In History this term, our focus will be to investigate why the Romans marched through County Durham and what impact they have had.

**We will be learning to:**

- look at causes and consequences of events.
- identify the key points made by an interpretation, linking primary sources
- explore features of Roman life.



## Maths

**In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on: Time and money.**

We will be learning to:

- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute.
- Record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours.
- Use vocabulary such as o'clock, a.m./p.m., morning, afternoon, noon and midnight.
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

## PE

We will be taking part in PE on **Monday and Friday**. The children will need to come to school in their PE kits for these days.



We will be learning and developing the skills needed to take part in Athletic activities; such as jumping long distance and throwing with accuracy.

## RE

This half term in RE, we will be exploring the religion of Hinduism and what followers of this religion believe.

We will be learning to:

- How beliefs impact on individuals and communities.
- Explore the Hindu beliefs of reincarnation and karma.



## Computing

**In Computing this half term, our focus will be on programming.**

We will be learning to:

- Design, write, and debug programs that accomplish specific goals.
- use sequence, selection, and repetition in programs
- Explain how some simple algorithms work, and to detect and correct errors in algorithms and programs

## Art

In Art this term our focus will be exploring the world around us.

We will be learning to:

- Use sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting & sculpture.
