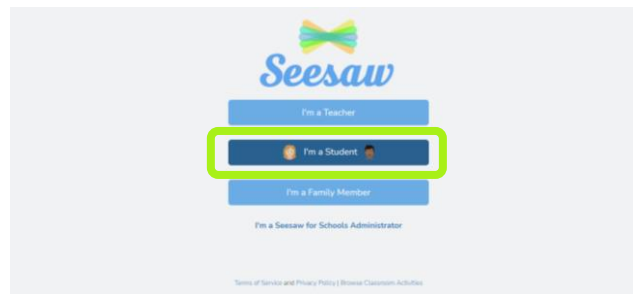




Using Seesaw A guide for Children and Parents

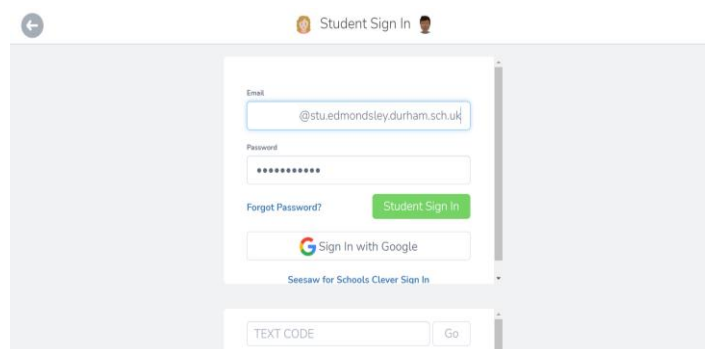
How to log-in - via an internet browser.

1. Log in by accessing the following webpage <https://app.seesaw.me/#/login>
2. Select 'I'm a student'



3. We are signing in via email. You should have received your child's log in from the school office, if you require this information again, please e-mail your child's class teacher.

Using a tablet/iPad.

Seesaw can be accessed via a tablet or iPad and works in exactly the same way as when using a laptop or computer. You can access using the web browser or by downloading the Seesaw Class app from your device's app store.

Completing Activities.

When your child logs on to their account, they will see a screen like the one below, but personalised to show their own name and class.


The red bubbles are notifications to inform you that there are activities to complete.

This example shows 5 activities on the activity tab which means there are 5 still to complete. The number 3 near the child's name shows that there are 3 **new** activities.



For each new activity you will see a set of instructions and any related documents or templates.

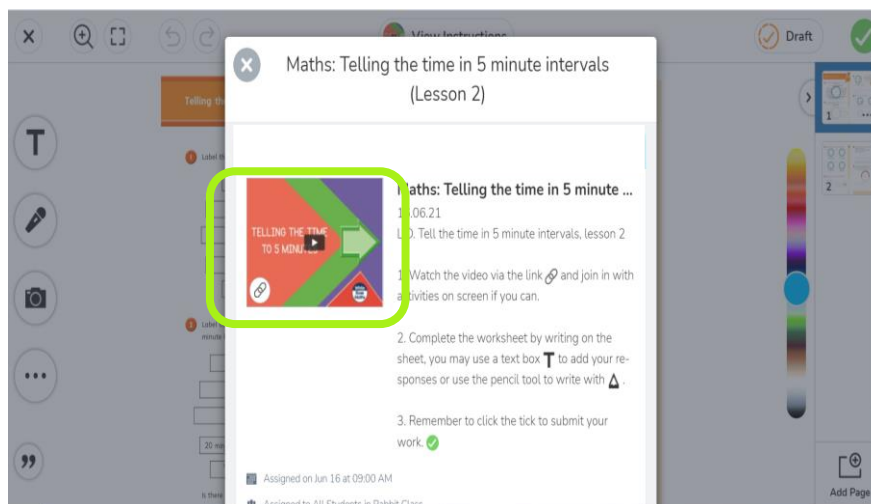
Some activities may include a video or other supporting documents to go alongside it, especially Maths, as seen below. Clicking the play button will open a new window allowing you to watch the video.



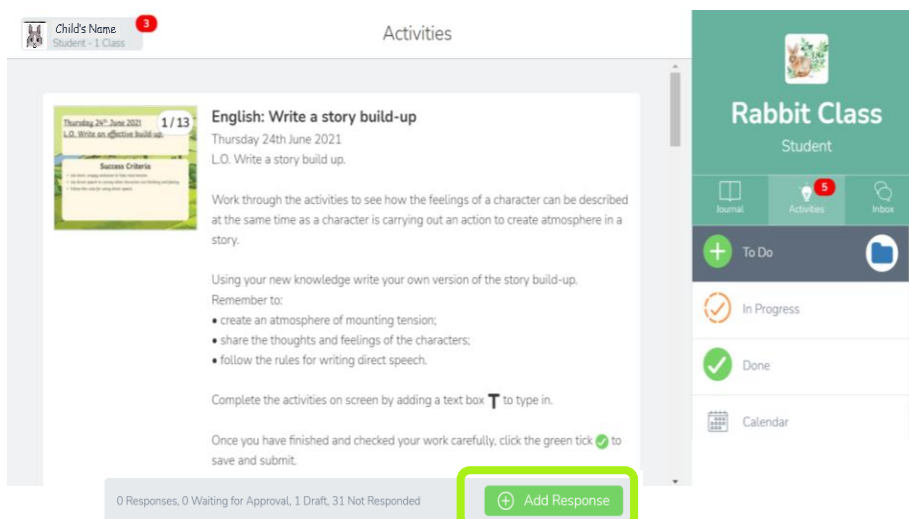
If you have opened the template on the activity you will need to go back to watch the video. You can do this by clicking 'View Instructions'.



This will open a new window, again click on the play button until the video appears.

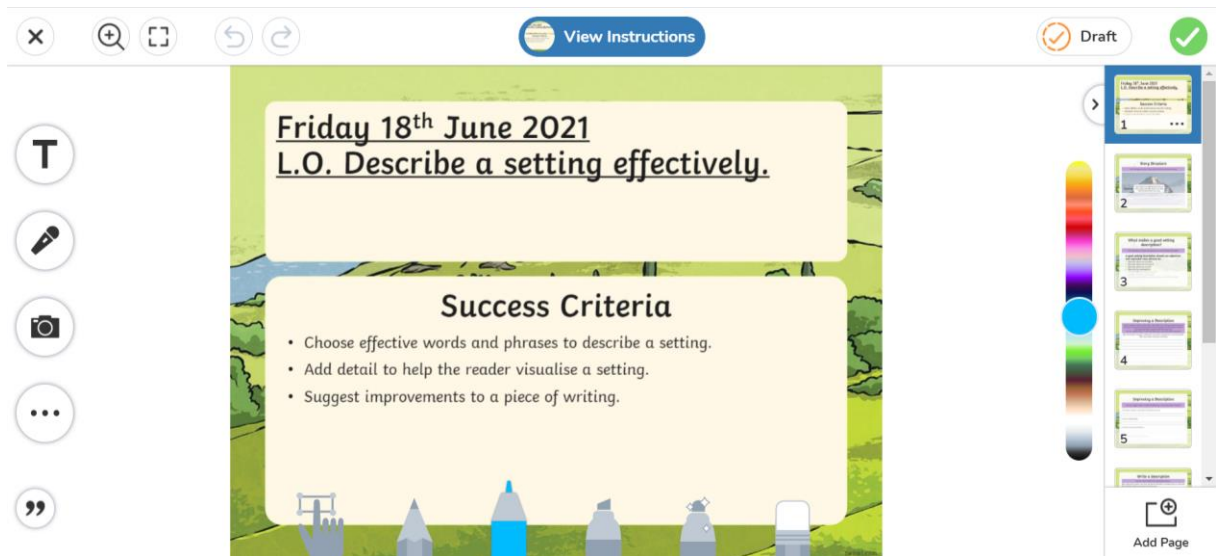


To complete an activity, you must click the 'add response' button.

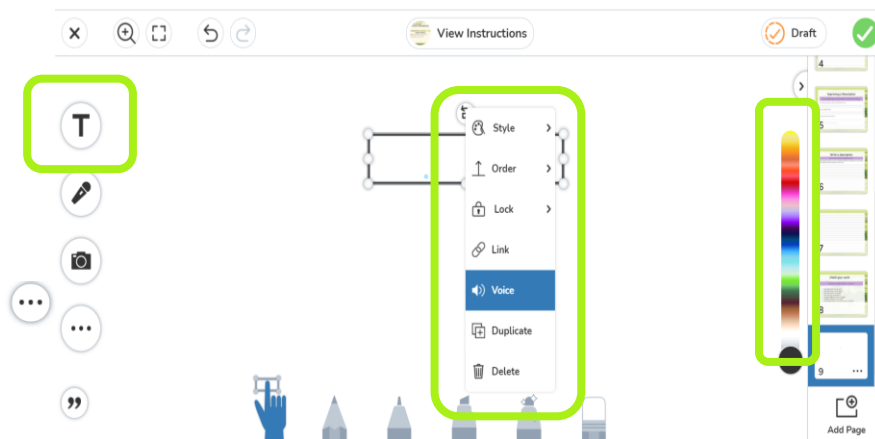


You will be taken to a new window, as shown below. This is the template that the teacher wants you to work on and edit.


As you can see there are a number of different options.



T This icon creates a text box on the page that can be typed in and moved around using your mouse. When you hover the mouse over the text box you will see 3 dots, clicking this will open up an options bar, as seen on the screen below, allowing you to alter the style, delete the text box, add a link or create a voice over.

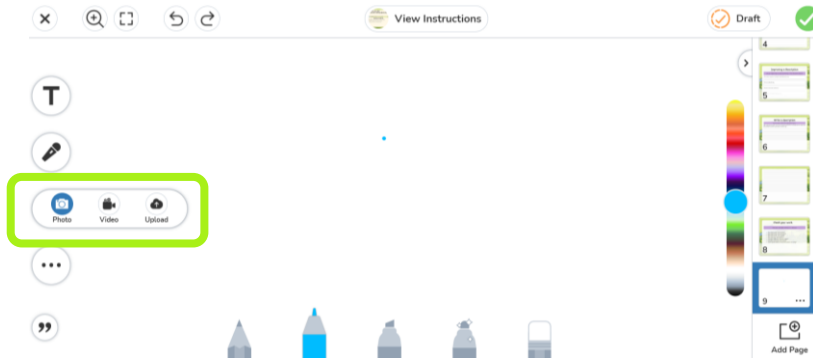


The colour of the text can be altered by using the rainbow toggle to the right of the page.

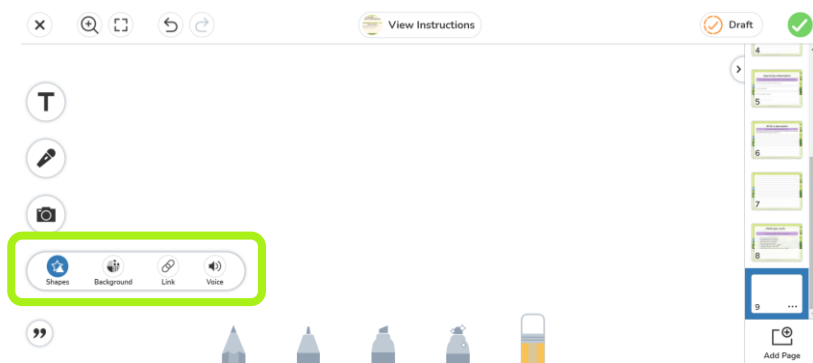
 This icon allows you to record using your device's microphone. This may be useful for tasks where your child has been asked to read aloud, play an instrument or explain something.



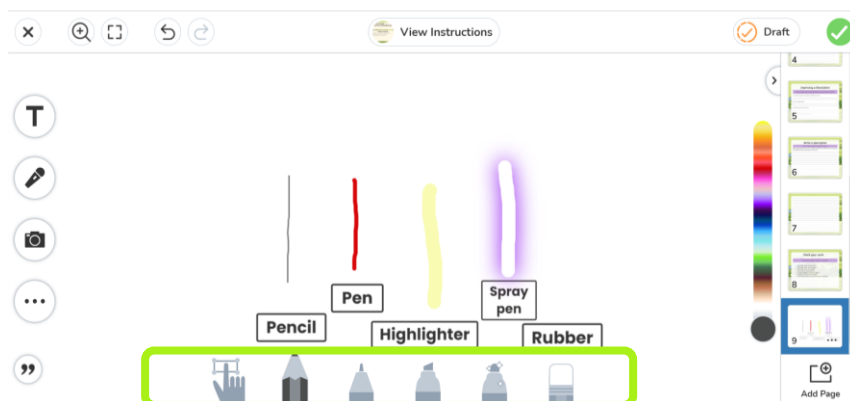
This icon brings out an additional menu when clicked, as shown below. It allows you to take a photograph or video using your device's camera. This may be useful for tasks where your child has been asked to use resources around the home, create artwork or perform. Again, this option could be used to explain something. You can also upload an existing image from your device.



This icon also brings out an additional menu, as shown below, which allows you to add shapes to your canvas, change the background, add a hyperlink or a voice note. When adding shapes or changing the background, another menu will appear with multiple options to choose from.



Along the bottom of the canvas are a selection of drawing tools, your child can use their fingers to control these on the screen of their device (if it is a touch screen) or Stylus Pens are available at a low cost online. The hand icon allows you to move objects such as text boxes and pictures around the canvas.





Add Page

This icon allows you to add additional pages of work.



This icon allows you to undo your actions if you make an error.



Draft

This icon allows you to save work as a draft, to continue later.



This icon saves and submits the work to the class teacher, it **must** be clicked in order for the teacher to read and respond.
