In English during this half term, we will be exploring:

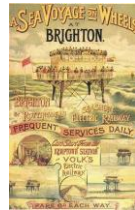


- poetry - Acrostics and Calligrams;

- instructions; and

History

In history our focus will be 'Holidays Now and Then'
We will be learning to:

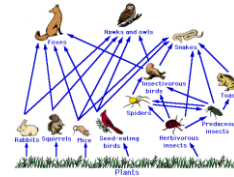
- use primary and secondary sources of information;
- compare and contrast holidays in the past to now;
- look at the language and understand the terms decades and centuries; and
- find similarities and differences between the 1950s era and the Victorian era.



Science

In Science during this half term, we will be considering what would happen if all the trees were cut down. We will be:

- understanding what is needed for something to be classified as living thing; and
- knowing simple food chains and webs and how changing one aspect of a habitat has an impact on others.

Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on:

- measurement (including time, capacity, mass and temperature); and
- problem solving.

Computing

In Computing this half term, our focus will be on computer science. The children will be learning to:

- debug more complex problems e.g. a route on a Bee Bot / Blue Bot / Probot / Alex / Logo etc... maze;
- create a dance algorithm in Scratch Junior; and
- with support use a safe search engine to find out information on the internet.

Art

In art this term, we will focus on the artwork of Van Gogh, Renoir, Sorolla and Peder Severin Krøyer as inspiration and the children will explore landscapes, particularly of the seaside!

We will be learning:

- to use a range of materials creatively to design and make products;
- to use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination;
- to develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space; and
- about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.
