### **English**

In English during this half term, we will be exploring the book 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King.

We will be investigating and writing:

- Persuasion
- Playscripts
- Narratives featuring issues and dilemmas.



### Maths

In Maths during this half term our focus will be on Place Value.

We will be learning to:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones).
- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1 000 000 and determine the value of each digit.
- Read Roman numerals to 1000.
- Use place value, known and derived facts to multiply and divide mentally, including: multiplying by 0 and 1; dividing by 1; multiplying together three numbers.

#### Science

In Science during this half term, we will be working to answer the question:

### Why could the platypus be a bird?

#### We will be doing this by:

- Exploring what it means to be a living thing.
- Comparing animals, classifying, and learning about life cycles and reproduction in animals.
- Describing differences and similarities and their importance.



### History

In History this half term our focus will be: Who were Britain's first hunter gatherers?
We will be learning:

- Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.
- Technology in the earliest settlements.
- Key features of an era and changes overtime.
