English

In English during this half term, we will read books related to toys.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Use symbols of + =;
- Sort, recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes;
- Compare and order numbers to 20; and
- Count forwards and backwards and write and read numbers to 20 in numerals and words.

We will be learning to sing songs in tune for our Christmas performance.

We will be learning how to play simple notation crotchets, quavers and rests.

History
