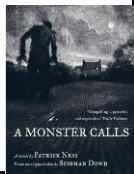


English

In English during this half term, we will be exploring the text 'A Monster Calls' by Patrick Ness' and writing a range of non-fiction relating to the text. We will be investigating and writing:

- Non-chronological reports
- Persuasion texts
- Discussion texts



Maths

In Maths during this half term, we will be able to:

- Multiply and divide using long division and multiplication methods.
- Add and subtract fractions
- Relate fractions to decimal and percentage equivalents.
- Use decimal notation in a range of real-life problems.
- Continue to develop our speed and recall of key facts within arithmetic.

Science

In Science during this half term, we will answer the question; How are things transported around our bodies? In particular, we will examine how the circulatory system works.

We will be learning to:

- Understand what blood does in the body.
- Explore how a healthy heart works.
- Explain how water is transported around the body.
- Investigate the effects of Drugs and medicines



Geography

In Geography this term, our focus will be to answer the questions: Where does our food come from?

We will be learning to:

- Understand where our food comes from.
- Explore how far our food has come.
- Understand what is meant by fair trade.
- To understand which of our foods are fair trade and how to detect this.
