

English

In English during this half term, we will be exploring the book 'Who Let the Gods Out?' by Maz Evans.

We will be exploring:

- Persuasive letter writing,
- Non-Chronological reports
- Playscripts
- Narratives writing involving issues and dilemmas.



Science

In Science during this half term our focus will be:

How can you purify water from a stream?

We will be learning to:

- Applying knowledge of solids, liquids, and gasses
- Exploring dissolving, crystallising, and filtering.



History

In History this term our focus will be to explore the Greeks

We will be learning:

- How the Greeks have shaped our world.
- Achievements and influences.
- Key features and individuals of ancient civilisation, consequences, and significance.



Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on: **Multiplication and Fractions.**

We will be learning to:

- recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions
- count up and down in hundredths; recognise that hundredths arise when dividing an object by 100 and dividing tenths by 10
- solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number
- add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundreds.

PE

We will be taking part in PE on **Monday and Friday.** This half-term we will be taking part in swimming lessons and we will be learning to develop our flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through Gymnastics.

In Computing this half term, our focus will be on **creating a podcast.**

We will be learning to:

- examine devices capable of recording digital audio
- understand the ownership of digital audio and the copyright implications of duplicating the work of others.
- use programmes to record and produce a podcast
- evaluate our own work and give feedback to our peers.

Art

In Art this term our focus will be on **Greek pottery.**

We will be learning to:

- Use sketch books to record observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting, and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]
- Learn about great artists, architects, and designers in history.
