

English

In English during this half term, we will be exploring:



- poetry - acrostics and calligrams;
- flow charts and diagrams; and
- narrative - stories from other cultures

Science

In Science during this half term, our focus will be living things and their habitats.

We will be learning to:

- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited.
- Describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants.

Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Statistics
- Fractions



Geography

In Geography this term, our focus will be on hot and cold places.

We will be learning to:

- Pupils will develop knowledge the Poles and Equator, looking at their location and some of the basic defining physical and human characteristics.
- Pupils will begin to develop an understanding of some features of the weather in hot and cold areas of the world and their effects.
- Pupils will use world maps of different types and globes to identify the continents, oceans, poles and equator.
- Pupils will use simple locational and directional language to describe features on different maps.
