Communication & Language

We have been building upon our listening and attention skills for a while now and the children have shown us that they love to listen to stories. The children will be given opportunities to recite the traditional tales that we read throughout the half term. The children will be provided with props which will allow them to do this during play.

Literacy

This half term, we will be reading a range of traditional tales. We will be reading each story repeatedly so that children become so familiar with the, they are able to recite it back to us and use their knowledge in their play.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Throughout this topic, we will cover many aspects of personal, social and emotional development. We will be looking at how the fox tricked the gingerbread man into climbing aboard, we will be looking at whether it was right of Goldilocks to go into the three bears' house when they weren't there, and we will explore how the three pigs felt when the wolf came to blow down their houses.

Understanding the World

This half term, the children will explore the changes that Spring brings. We have already noticed that the daffodils have started to grow in our garden, which was very exciting! We will be looking at the change in weather and why that is important as the plants and leaves start to grow back. We will also look at planting some of our own vegetables.
