English

In English during this half term, we will be exploring the book Gangsta Granny.

We will be writing:

- Explanation texts
- Poetry
- Instructions

Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on: Fractions, decimals, including money and percentages.

We will be learning to:

- find equivalent fractions, compare and order fractions and find a fraction of an amount.
- find the effect of dividing a one- or two-digit number by 10 and 100 identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths
- round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number
- compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places
- solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

Science

In Science during this half term our focus will be:

What can affect the sounds we hear?

We will be learning to:

- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it and the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it
- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

Geography

In Geography this term our focus will be to explore why we have cities.

We will be learning:

- The names and locations of the major cities of the UK and the difference between a city and a town. The key features of cities will be introduced with accurate terminology to include site and function.
- Pupils will use geographical data including from maps and information to look at the key features and functions of cities.

PE

We will be taking part in PE on Monday and Thursday.

This half-term we will be taking part in football lessons and we will be learning to develop technique, control and team work through dodge ball.

Children will need to come to school in their PE kits on Monday and Thursday.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring why Lent is such an important time for Christians. We will be learning:

- \bullet $\;$ That Lent is a time of giving up and explore some ways that Christians give things up
- The different practices of Christians during Lent
- That Lent is a time of giving charitably and reflect on ways Christians may give to others.

Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will be on modifying a code using the programme Scratch.

We will be learning to:

- Develop the use of count-controlled loops in a different programming environment.
- To develop a design that includes two or more loops which run at the same time.
- To design a project that includes repetition.


D&T
