

English

In English during this half term, we will read books related to the four nations of the United Kingdom.

With support, we will focus on:

- using phonic knowledge to continue to read and write words and sentences;
- writing captions, labels and lists;
- reading and writing simple instructions;
- sequence short narratives pictorially; and
- organise writing correctly (left to right, top to bottom).

Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on measurement and multiplication & division.

We will be learning to:

- compare and measure capacity;
- compare and measure mass;
- make equal groups;
- make arrays; and
- make doubles.



Science

In Science during this term, our question will be 'Which plants can we discover at Edmondsley?'

We will be thinking about the following questions as well as starting to plant and grow crops in our school allotment.

- How do we plant a seed?
- How do seeds grow?
- What wild plants can we spot?
- What can we grow in a garden?



Geography

In Geography this half term, our focus will be the 'Best of Britain'



We will be learning to:

- develop their locational and place knowledge of the United Kingdom to include: the four countries which make up the United Kingdom, their capital cities, the names of the surrounding seas, key characteristics of the four countries;
- develop knowledge of weather as a physical process;
- identification of daily weather patterns in the UK;
- use an atlas, a globe and maps; and
- compare similarities and differences between the four nations.

- insert pictures.

Art

In Art this term, our focus will be on the artist Joan Miro.



- Children will learn about Spanish Catalan artist, Joan Miró, and all about his Magical Realist paintings.
- Children will then draw on their own experiences to create dream-like pictures about their own lives.
- Children will have great fun exploring printmaking with lots of different objects and materials to illustrate a nonsense alphabet.
- Children will love using their imaginations as they delve into Miró's Surrealist paintings and sculptures, learning new techniques and making their own unique, colourful, and exciting artwork.
