

English

In English during this half-term, we will be exploring the book Anglo-Saxon Boy by Tony Bradman.



We will be writing:

- Character descriptions
- Persuasive writing
- News reports including commentary and an article.

Science

In Science during this half-term our key question is:

How can we get an object up and down a hill using the least amount of effort?

We will be learning to:

- Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object (NC)
- Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces (NC)
- Recognise that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect (NC)

History

In History this half-term will be explore what happened when the Romans left Britain (Anglo-Saxons).

We will be learning:

- Why the Romans left Britain and what happened after.
- Who invaded Britain when the Romans left?
- Who was in charge in Anglo Saxon England.
- About life on an Anglo-Saxon farm.
- Who were the Anglo Saxons' enemies?
- About the significance of Alfred, the Great.

Maths

In Maths during this half-term, our objectives will focus on Statistics and Shape:

We will be learning to:

- interpret and present discrete and continuous data using appropriate graphical methods, including bar charts and time graphs
- solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs
- compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals and triangles, based on their properties and sizes
- identify acute and obtuse angles and compare and order angles up to 2 right angles by size
- identify lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes presented in different orientations

PE

We will be taking part in PE on Monday and Tuesday.

We will be learning to:

- Know how to change font size and style; include shapes and backgrounds and to use the Spellcheck function
- produce a piece of work related to other learning
- Use sequencing to create an effective presentation or video Keynote, PowerPoint or iMovie.

Art

In Art this half-term our focus will be Anglo-Saxon art. We will be:

- Using sketch books to record our observations and use them to review and revisit ideas.
- Develop artistic/visual vocabulary when talking about our own work and that of others
- Improving our mastery of art and design techniques.
- Learning about great artists, architects and designers in history
