

English

In English during this half-term, we will be exploring the book *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by C. S. Lewis.



We will be writing:

- Setting descriptions
- Narrative writing
- Using dialogue to convey character and advance the action

Maths

In Maths during this half-term, our objectives will focus on **Geometry and Measurement** including **Position and direction**, **Converting units** and **Volume**:

We will be learning to:

- Describe position and draw on a grid
- Understand position in the first quadrant
- Understand translation and translation with coordinates
- Use lines of symmetry and investigate reflection
- Consolidate our learning of volume

Science

In Science during this half-term our key question is:

Can we prove Galileo was right?

We will be learning to:

- Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun in the solar system.
- Describe the movement of the moon relative to the Earth.
- Describe the sun, Earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies.
- Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Geography

In Geography this half-term our key question is: **What shapes my world?**

We will be learning:

- About locations, and places showing evidence of physical and human processes in shaping the landscape.
- That physical processes have shaped and continue to alter the landscape and affect the lives of the people who live in different places.
- To gather information and pose geographical questions, using photographs as evidence.
- Use atlases, globes and other sources of geographical information.

PE

We will be taking part in PE on **Monday and Thursday**. This half-term we will be taking part in rounders, we will also be improving our teamwork, problem-solving and map skills during outdoor adventurous activities.

The children will need to come to school in their **PE kits** on **Mondays and Thursdays**.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the key question: What do we now know about Christianity?

We will be learning:

- What beliefs Christians have.
- What the main source of authority is in Christianity and why.
- How Christians express their beliefs and the impact of these beliefs for Christians.

Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will be on **Information Technology**

We will be learning to:

Know how to break sets of instructions into short steps to achieve goal. For instance, drawing repeated squares to make a pattern.



Design & Technology

In D&T this half-term our focus will be to design, make and evaluate a buzzer game.

We will be learning to:

- Investigate and analyse a range of existing products.
- Research and develop design criteria to inform the design of innovative, functional and appealing products that are fit for purpose and aimed at particular individuals or groups.
- Select from and use a wide range of equipment, materials and components.
- Understand and use electrical systems.

Personal, Social, Health, Relationship and Citizenship Education

PSHRC this half-term our focus will be **"What's Next?"**

We will be learning to:

- Thinking about some of the things in our lives that we can change and how we feel about them.
- Understand other people's behaviour by thinking about what they might be feeling or thinking.
- Know that sometimes there can be positive outcomes from changes that they didn't like at first.

French

In this unit we will learn how to:

Use regular verbs including; personal pronouns, verb stems and endings, regular -er verbs, regular -ir verbs and regular -re verbs.
