Science

In Science during this half term, we will be working to answer these questions: How do we see? How does light travel? We will do this by:

- Investigating light travelling in a straight line .
- Plan and carry out a range of investigations on a range of materials to test reflection.
- Finding a pattering between shadows and light.
- Knowing how to protect our eyes from the sun.

Maths

In Maths during this half term our focus will be on fractions, capacity and mass.

We will do this by:

- Identifying the numerators and denominators.
- Ordering fractions from smallest to the biggest by knowing the rules for when the numerators are the same and denominators are the same.
- Identifying Unit and a Non-unit fraction and a whole.
- Measuring in millilitres, litres and grams.
- Knowing how to convert between measurements.
- Identifying how to subtract and add capacity.
- Comparing capacity and mass.

English

• In English during this half term, we will be studying the novel, "Running Wild" by Michael Morpurgo. We will also be looking at the poems Catch a little rhyme and Burning Bright by William Blake poem

These text will be cementing our writing skills.

- We will be writing a range of texts such as:
 - Newspaper
 - Letters
 - Descriptive writing
 - Short poem



Music

In Music this half term, our focus will be learning to play the Ukulele

We will be:

- Use and understand staff and other musical notation.
- Play new pieces by ear and from simple notations.
- Recognise and explore the ways sounds can be combined and used expressively.
