English

We will be running a booster after school class on

Mondays', for Y6. This half-term, we will be reading Room 13 by Robert Swindles. We will use this book to develop children's narrative writing skills. How to build tension and suspense through sentence structure. Writing a review to persuade people to stay at the hotel, in the story. Writing book reviews.

In Poetry we will be reading Jaberrwocky, by Lewis Carrol. We will continue to do handwriting, daily, along with learning rules of spelling.

Geography

This term, we will be looking at North & South America. Comparing a region from the Americas to County Durham. Learning about the names of certain countries in the America's, along with names of capital cities. Along key geographical features of these countries. Going to Waldridge Fell, for a field trip. Comparing the flora and fauna of Waldridge Fell, to that of a region in Canada.

French

In French the children will be learning vocabulary related to the family

PSHCE

Music

Using Charanga, on-line program children will learn a new song. Listening to the rhythm and clapping out the rhythm. Along with learning to beat out the rhythm of a song on a musical instrument

PE

We will be taking part in PE on Tuesday and Wednesday.

P.E. Team Building Skills; the children will learn, how to follow instructions and to co-operate with team members. Cricket; in cricket children will develop skills of throwing and catching a ball. Bowling under arm to a target and striking the ball with a bat.

Maths

An Y6 booster class will be run, after school on a Thursday.

This half-term, Year 6 will focussing on the following objectives; decimal place value, rounding decimals multiplying and dividing decimals by ten 10, 100, 1000, equivalent fractions, relationship between fractions, decimals, and percentages. Also how to calculate area, perimeter and volume

Year 5 will be focussing on these objectives; Decimals up to two places, equivalent fractions and decimals, how to calculate the area and perimeter of a shape. Children in Stag class will continue to practise their times tables on a daily basis.

Design Technology

In DT this term our focus will be Global food, from around the world.

The children will discover the exciting and diverse choice of food available around the world. They will then build on their understanding of the Eat well plate, placing different ingredients into the correct food groups. Along with planning making and evaluating food from a variety of countries.
