

## English

In English during this half-term, we will be looking at T-rex Terror by Ash Stone, The Word is a Box by Sophie Hannah and Listen by John Hegley. Our Poem is Marbles by Michael Kavanagh.

We will be writing:

- New reports
- Poetry writing
- Narrative writing
- Review Writing

## Maths

In Maths during this half-term, our objectives will focus on properties of shape and statistics:

We will be learning to:

- Read and interpret bar charts, pictograms and line graphs
- Draw our own bar charts and pictograms
- Name angles
- Compare and order angles
- Understand vertical and horizontal lines, including parallel and perpendicular lines

## RE

In RE, we will be exploring the key question:

**What do Christians believe about God?**

In addition to this, we will be answering the following questions:

- How is God shown to protect and save?
- Why do Christians believe God is so powerful?
- How do Christians believe in three in one?

## Personal, Social, Health, Relationship and Citizenship Education

PSHRC this half-term our focus will be **How to keep ourselves active and sleep well.**

We will be learning to:

- Find ways to help us sleep and be calm
- Investigate the best ways to keep active, both mentally and physically.
- Explain why it is important to get enough sleep and explain what happens when we don't get enough sleep
- Explain why it's important to be active.

## Science

In Science during this half-term our key question is:

How do our shadows change over a day and over a year? What materials create the best shadow?

We will be learning to:

- Identify opaque materials that create shadows.
- Conduct experiments that show how shadows change.
- Identify the reasons why shadows may get wider or bigger.

## Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will be on **Date input**:

We will be learning to:

- Collect date and information
- Log data and present it in different forms.

## Music

In Music this half term, our focus will be **practising the Ukulele and guitar**:

We will be learning to:

- Play new pieces by ear and from simple notations.
- Identify and control different ways instruments make sounds.

## Geography

In Geography this half-term our key question is:

**How does the water cycle work? What is produced in our local area?**

We will be learning:

- To gather information and pose geographical questions, using photographs as evidence.
- The different parts of a river
- Observe and investigate the fastest part of a river.
- Understand the significance of the water cycle.

## PE

We will be taking part in PE on Tuesday and Friday.

This half-term we will be taking part in dance lessons. We will create our own routines and look at a variety of dances including:

- Line Dancing
- Street Dancing
- Abstract Dancing

The children will need to come to school in PE kits on a Tuesday and a Friday.



## Art

In art this half-term we will be looking at if the Romans were vicious and the weapons they used.

We will be learning to:

- Create and design Roman mosaics.
- Discover what weapons the Romans used through primary resources such as pictures.
- We will use chalk and pencil to create our patterns.
