#### Science

In Science during this half term, we will focus on sound. We will be doing this by:

- identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- · recognise that vibrations from sounds travel to the ear
- find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it
- find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it

## Maths

In Maths during this half term our focus will be on

We will continue to develop our skills in the four operations by;

- Numbers to 100.000
- Subtracting numbers that include exchanges
- Learn multiplication facts for 3, 6, 7 and 9 times tables
- Begin to divide numbers
- Use multiplication and division facts
- Factors, common multiples and prime numbers

Whilst learning new skills, children will continue to consolidate their existing knowledge of place value.

#### English

In English during this half term, we will be studying the picture books, Tuesday by David Weisner and Door by JiHyeon Lee. We will also develop and understanding of new poetry.

We will be writing a range of texts such as:

- News Report
- Writing to entertain
- Suspense writing
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person narratives.

Whilst exploring new texts we will also continue to develop our reading skills.

#### History

In History this half term, our focus will be Ancient Egyptians.

We will be:

- beginning to show an understanding of key terms such as mummification, culture.
- inferring information from artefacts about what life was like in Ancient Egypt.
- describing similarities and differences from the past and give reasons for some of these.

## PE

We will be taking part in PE on <u>Tuesday and Friday</u>. The children will need to come to school in their PE kits on a Tuesday. Children will need their swimming kit on a Friday.

Children will:

- develop teambuilding skills, control and problem solving skills.
- Develop their water safety and survival skills.

### RE

This half term in RE, we will be learning about Judaism.

Through this study we will learn about why Moses is important to Jewish people. This first unit will allow children to develop understanding of Judaism before focussing on the importance of the role and person of Moses within Judaism.

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# Personal, Social, Health, Relationship and Citizenship Education

In PSHRCE this term our focus will be on Relationships within families. We will learn:

- how families differ from each other (including that not every family has the same family structure, e.g., single parents, same sex parents, step-parents, blended families, foster and adoptive parents)
- how common features of positive family life often include shared experiences, e.g. celebrations, special days or holidays
- · how people within families should care for each other and the different ways they demonstrate this
- how to ask for help or advice if family relationships are making them feel unhappy, worried or unsafe

# Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will be learning about creating media through audio production.

Through this unit we will:

- I can describe effective ways people can manage passwords (e.g. storing them securely or saving them in the browser).
- Learn how to create media.
- Think about how audio is created and suited to a particular audience.

## Art and design

In Art we will be learning:

- How we can create different effects when drawing portraits.
- Analysing portraits.
- Creating tone and texture in our portraits.
- How to use charcoal, pen and pencil effectively.

#### Music

In Music we will learn to:

- Recite the lyrics to 'Let your spirit fly'
- Find the pulse of the music
- Vocal warm ups
