

English

In English during this half term, our children will continue to be taught in their RWI groups. Each group will be reading different stories and continuing to develop phonic knowledge to read, spell and write. This ensures the children are accessing books specific to their stage of phonics development. As a year group we will be reading fiction, including animal stories, traditional nursery rhymes, traditional tales, tales with a twist and poetry. We will also be reading non-fiction linked to the world around us.

Maths

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on number and place value. We will be learning to:

- sort and count objects;
- represent numbers;
- count forwards and backwards;
- count one more/one less;
- compare numbers using symbols;
- order objects and numbers;
- learn the whole part model; and
- learn addition families and symbol.

Art (or) Design Technology

In Design Technology this term, children will explore cooking and nutrition, creating their own 'Sensational Salads'. We will:

- Use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes
- Understand where food comes from

We will also be undertaking a School Enterprise Project using fruit from our very own school allotment.

RE

In RE this half term, we will be asking the question, 'What can we learn about Christianity by visiting a church?'

We will be exploring:

- Why Churches are important places for Christians
- How the church is used for worship
- The special role of the vicar/priest/minister
- The role of the local church in the community
- Special times in church such as the festival of Harvest

Science

In Science during this half term, our focus will be on materials.

We will be thinking about the following questions:

- What materials can we find around our environment?
- What are materials like?
- Which materials are magnetic?
- How can we sort objects?
- Which materials are suitable for building?



Geography (or) History

In Geography this half term, our focus will be 'Where do I come from?'



We will be learning to:

- use maps and aerial photographs to inform investigations of school, grounds and the local area;
- develop simple knowledge about their locality; and
- develop locational knowledge about their schools and homes.

Computing

In Computing this half term, our focus will be on using a computer independently.



We will be learning how to:

- Log onto a computer or use a QR code to evidence work;
- Log in to a computer;
- Navigate around the screen with a mouse; and
- Type using a keyboard.

Personal, Social, Health, Relationship and Citizenship Education

In PSHRCE this term our focuses will be, 'What is the same and different about us?' and 'Who is special to us?'

We will be considering the following ideas:

- What rules are, why they are needed, and why different rules are needed for different situations (create Class Agreement)
- Things they can do to help look after their environment (Class Pledge)
- Different roles and responsibilities people have in their community (School Council nomination/elections & Class responsibilities/roles)
