

Science

In Science during this half term, we will focus on Forces and think carefully about how the size of the force can impact change. Children will know and remember

- I know that gravity is a force which pulls objects to the centre of the universe.
- I know that water resistance, air resistance and friction slows things down and makes it harder to move.
- I know that mechanisms such as levers, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

Maths

In Maths during this half term our focus will be on

- Fractions
- Decimals.

We will also continue to develop our skills in the four operations. Whilst learning new skills, children will continue to consolidate their existing knowledge of place value. Deer Class are striving to develop their Times Table knowledge.

Music

In Music we will learn to:

- Use new vocabulary such as: improvise, compose, pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo, dynamics, texture structure, melody
- Perform and share **The Dragon Song**

Personal, Social, Health, Relationship and Citizenship Education

In PSHRCE this term our focus will be on What strengths, skills and interests do we have?

Children will learn:

- how to recognise personal qualities and individuality
- to develop self-worth by identifying positive things about themselves and their achievements
- how their personal attributes, strengths, skills and interests contribute to their self-esteem
- how to set goals for themselves

English

In English during this half term, we will be studying 'Rumaysa A Fairytale' and 'A Climate in Chaos'. We will also continue to develop our understanding of poetry by looking at Russian Doll by Rachael Rooney.

We will be writing a range of texts such as:

- Instructions
- Historical fiction writing
- Formal report writing

Whilst exploring new texts we will also continue to develop our reading skills.

Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will be learning about Programming and repetition in games.
