

## As 'Happy Chatters' we will...

This half term, we will be working on our language development, doing lots of work around tenses, which link to our theme of 'change'. We will be accessing activities that encourage recall and thinking about past experiences and continuing to partake in group time together. We will continue to read stories, sing and recite nursery rhymes and finger rhymes on a daily basis.

## As 'Brilliant Bookworms' and 'Wow Writers' we will...

In literacy this half term, we will be encouraging lots of mark making and creating. We will engage in conversation around our drawings/creations and the stories that they link to. We will continue to have a 'story of the week' which will be read multiple times a day. We will continue to work on recognising our names and having a go writing them on our drawings.



## As 'Fantastic Friends' we will...

This half term, we will be taking part in circle times to help with our understanding of resolving conflicts.

We will be learning about healthy choices and will be able to talk about healthy fruit and vegetables.



## As 'Edmondsley Explorers' we will...

This half term, we will be making the most of the nice weather in our beautiful grounds. We will be looking at animals and minibeasts that live in our garden and exploring the habitats that they thrive in. We will be looking at the changes we notice in the environment as the season progresses, particularly in our allotment, as well as changes in our own lives.

## As 'Marvellous Mathematicians' we will...

This half term, we will be using lots of mathematical language, focusing on numbers 1-5 and beyond. We will be working on:

Counting from 1-5, beginning to recognise numerals 0 - 10, linking numerals and amounts (e.g. adding 5 pencils to a pot labelled 5), comparing quantities such as more than and fewer than and lots more!

## As 'Energetic Caterpillars' we will...

We will continue to work on our fine motor skills this half term as well as practicing our cutting skills with scissors. As our fingers strengthen, we will be able to demonstrate a greater level of control when handling tools and mark making. We will continue to have our weekly PE sessions on a **Monday and Thursday** and we will be working on skills such as throwing and catching in our garden.
